

# High School Art Competition

## December 6, 2024

### GUIDELINES & GALLERY REQUIREMENTS

#### ELIGIBILITY

- Any current Kalamazoo area senior or junior in high school is eligible to participate.
- All types of artwork are eligible

#### NUMBER OF ENTRIES

- Each person may submit one piece of artwork.
- All work must have been completed within the past two years.
- Work must not have been entered in any previous shows.
- Students who are part of a program (ex. KRESA) should enter under the program instead of their high school.

#### DELIVERY

- **Students must prepare, finalize and deliver their work on their own and in conjunction with all other guidelines for submission.**
- **Students accepted into the show must submit a physical copy of their artwork unless their work is a video/animation.**
- Digital entries for the show will be accepted for consideration until 4 p.m. on Nov. 1, 2024. Students should provide high-resolution digital images for the initial submission process. Digital images and movie files can be emailed to Cindy Parks at [cparks@kvcc.edu](mailto:cparks@kvcc.edu) or delivered to Cindy at the Center for New Media on the Arcadia Commons Campus. Please call at 269.373.7881 to schedule a drop-off time.
- Acceptance notifications will go out to instructors and students on Nov. 11, 2024.
- All student submissions received digitally and accepted for the December Art Hop Exhibit should be delivered to the Center for New Media.
- Physical entries are due by 3:30 p.m. on Nov. 22, 2024.
- Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form.
- If the artist is unable to deliver their work during these times, a representative may be sent. Please provide them with a completed call for entry form or the following information: Your name, Address, Phone #, Title of Work, and Price (if applicable).
- Exhibit opens at 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 6 and awards will be presented at 6:30 p.m.

#### CONDITION OF ENTRIES

- **All work must be prepared and ready for final display. If needed, please provide any special instructions for proper installation of work. 2D art MUST BE FRAMED and ready for hanging with proper wire. No clip frames will be allowed. Improperly presented works will be disqualified.**
- Digital work such as videos, animations, etc., must be submitted via flash drive or email. Please label flash drives with your name to ensure it is returned to you.
- All other forms of artwork must be submitted fully ready to be displayed.
- Appointments are MANDATORY. Drop-ins are not accepted. Campus doors remain locked at all times so an appointment is necessary to ensure someone is available to accept your work.
- Arrive at the middle sliding door. Appointments are available Mon. - Fri., 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- Please label the back of the artwork with your name and the title of your piece.

#### CATEGORIES

- All forms of creative art and mediums will be accepted.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: Drop-off and pick-up of all artwork is the responsibility of the artist. The college reserves the right to eliminate any piece. Kalamazoo Valley Community College, its departments, services and individuals, or anyone involved in the collaboration or sponsoring of this show, do not assume any responsibility for entries lost or damaged during the show.**
