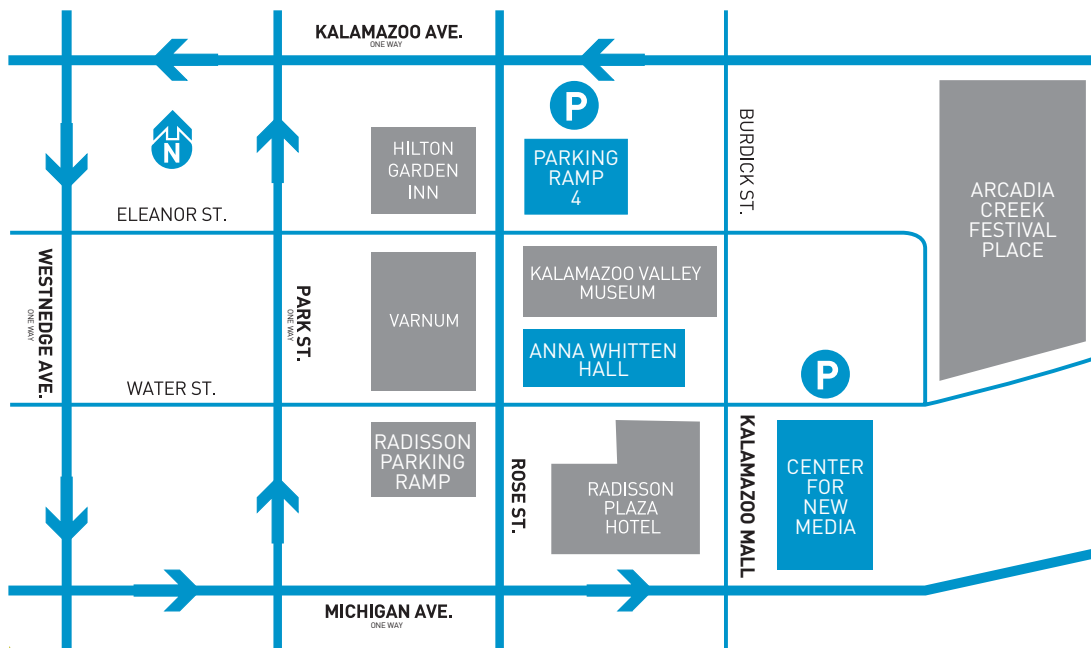


DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

Bus Route #11 Stadium

Exit at Rose Street, Bay 1 (Kalamazoo Metro Transit Office)

Directions From Texas Township Campus to the Arcadia Commons Campus

Take I-94 east to the Oakland Drive exit #75 and turn left at the light. Follow Oakland Drive north. Oakland Drive will merge with Stadium Drive and then merge with Michigan Avenue. Follow Michigan Avenue to Rose Street and turn left. Anna Whitten Hall will be on your right. For Center for New Media, turn right on Water Street - the CNM will be on your right.

Arcadia Commons Parking

Kalamazoo Valley will provide parking for students who are currently enrolled in at least one course at the Arcadia Commons Campus. Parking is validated in either the front office of Anna Whitten Hall or at the receptionist desk at the Center for New Media. Parking is in Ramp 4 only, located one block north of the campus at the corner of Eleanor and Rose Streets.

Arcadia Commons Parking FAQ's

Can I purchase a parking pass? No purchase necessary! Students with current registration in classes at the Arcadia Campus (AWH & CNM) are eligible to receive free parking while attending to academic activities. You will need a Kalamazoo Valley Student ID card to receive parking validation.

How does parking work? Park in Ramp #4. Two entrances: one at the corner of Eleanor and Rose Street and the other on Kalamazoo Ave just before Rose Street. You can get a validation ticket for the ramp by scanning your Valley ID at the front desk of Anna Whitten Hall or Center for New Media during office hours. If your class falls outside of office hours, you will need to get your validation ticket before the office closes.

Directions From Texas Township Campus to the Marilyn J. Schlack Culinary/Allied Health Building

Take I-94 east to the Westnedge Ave. exit #76A and turn left at the light. Follow Westnedge Ave. north, then take a right onto E. Crosstown Pkwy. Continue on E. Crosstown Pkwy., take a left onto Jasper St. Take a right onto Walnut St., the Culinary/Allied Health Building will be on your right.

Directions From Texas Township Campus to the Food Innovation Center

Take I-94 east to the Westnedge Ave. exit #76A and turn left at the light. Follow Westnedge Ave. north, then take a right onto E. Crosstown Pkwy. Turn right onto John St., and the entrance to the Food Innovation Center will be on your left.

Bronson Healthy Living Campus Parking

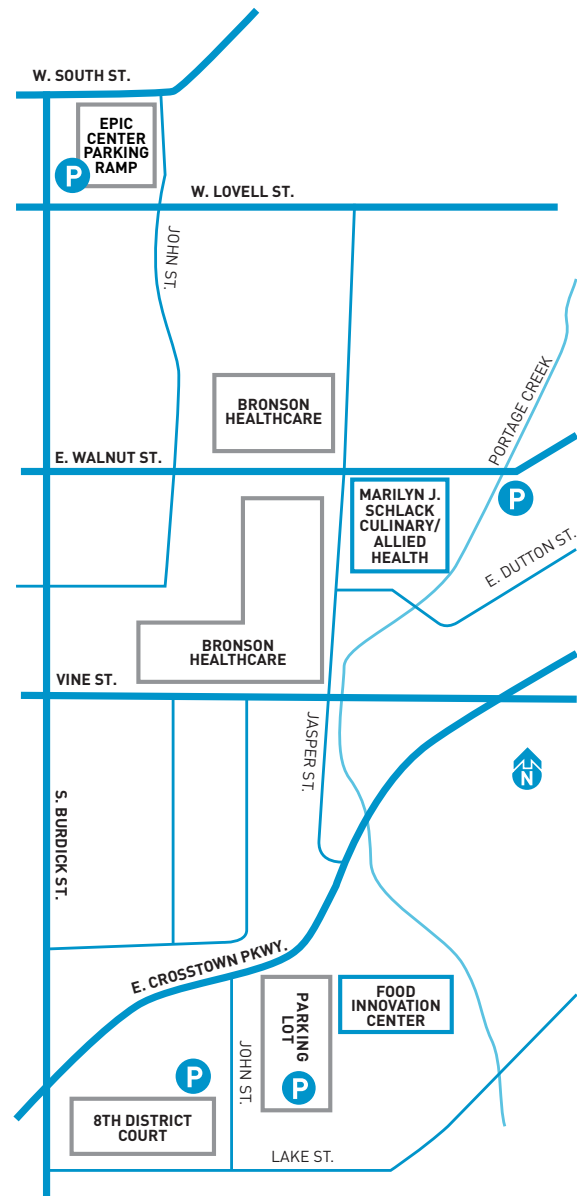
Kalamazoo Valley will provide parking for students who are currently enrolled in at least one course at the Bronson Healthy Living Campus. Parking is free in the student parking lots located east of the Portage Creek on E. Walnut St. and off John St. at the Food Innovation Center. Overflow parking is available at the Epic Center Parking Ramp.

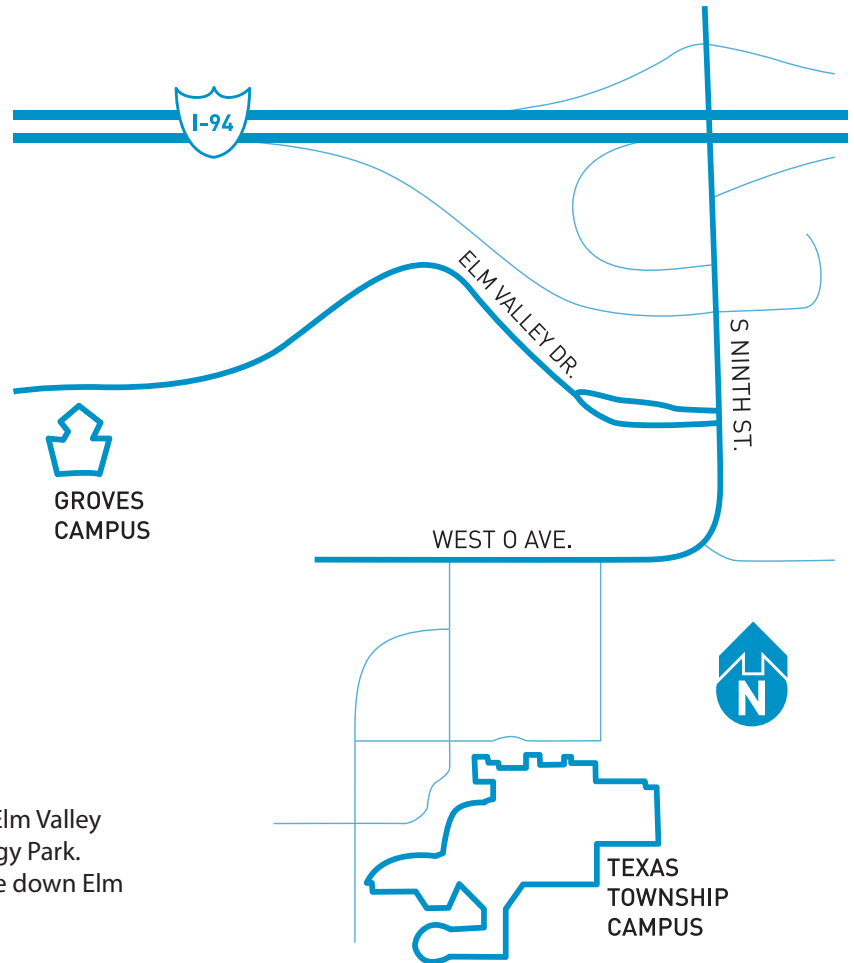

How does parking work at the Epic Center Ramp?

Validated parking is available at the Epic Center Parking Ramp. Two entrances: one at E. Lovell St. and one on E. South St. You can get a validated ticket for the ramp by scanning your Valley ID at the front desk at the Marilyn J. Schlack Culinary and Allied Health Building during office hours. If your class falls outside of office hours, you will need to get your validation ticket before the office closes.

Directions From Texas Township Campus

Head onto 9th Street heading south. Turn right onto Elm Valley Drive into The Groves - Education, Business, Technology Park.

The Groves Campus is located approximately one mile down Elm Valley Drive, on the left.

Groves Campus Parking FAQ's

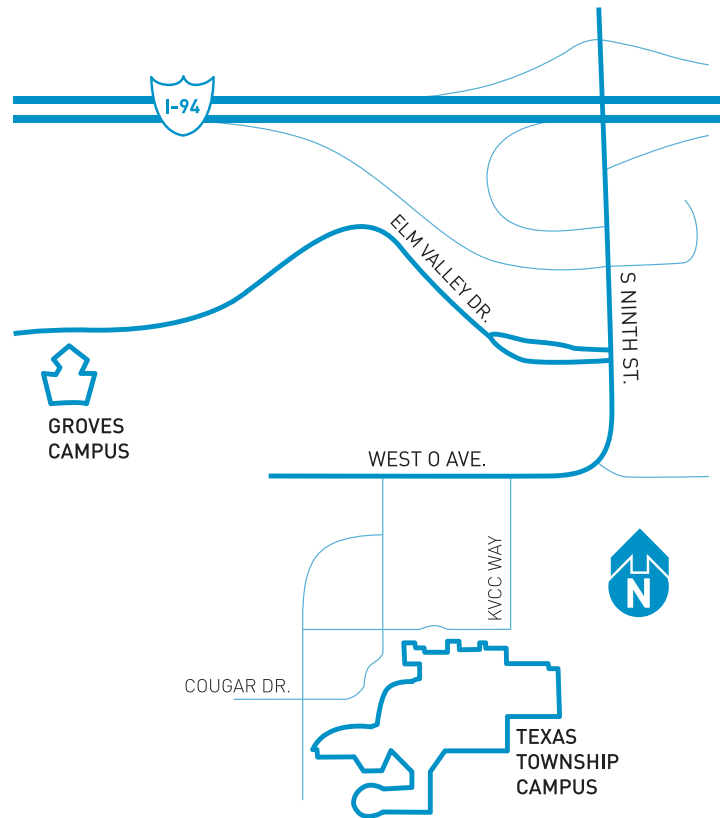
Can I purchase a parking pass? No purchase necessary! Parking is free and open to students. No parking pass needed.

Directions to Texas Township Campus

Take I-94 to Exit 72 – Ninth Street.

Turn onto 9th Street going south. The Texas Township Campus is located approximately 0.8 miles from the interstate on the left. Turn left on KVCC Way or the following entrance at Cougar Dr. North.

Are there any parking regulations? Traffic and parking on the Texas Township Campus is regulated by the State of Michigan, Kalamazoo County and a Texas Township Board of Trustees ordinance. All persons operating a motor vehicle on the campus shall be regulated by this ordinance. The ordinance is enforced by the Kalamazoo Valley Department of Public Safety.
