If you feel your scores do not represent your skill level, you should review the individualized learning modules within the ALEKS platform.

When you initially took the ALEKS test, you created an ALEKS account. ALEKS has custom learning modules based on the results from your first test. The modules serve as a refresher on those topics. You are allowed up to four retakes over a six-month period.

To review on ALEKS:

- 1. Go to www.aleks.com and sign into your account.
- 2. Work through the Learning Modules. It is recommended that you spend about 30 40 minutes a day for at least a week before taking ALEKS a second time. By spending as little as 40 minutes a day for a week, you might find your retake score improves several points.
- 3. Spend a minimum of three hours or more in the Learning Modules before retaking the placement test. Do not cram your review into one sitting! Best results are achieved with 30 to 40 minutes a day of focused learning for a week before attempting to retest.
